us, so we and all your children shall be free,  
and the whole earth live to praise your name;  
through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen**

## Sermon

### We affirm our faith

Let us affirm our faith  
in Jesus Christ the Son of God  
**Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord God almighty,  
Who was, and is, and is to come**

We believe in God the Father  
who created all things,  
**For by his will they were created  
and have their being**

We believe in God the Son who was slain,  
**For with his blood he purchased us for God  
from every tribe and language,  
from every people and nation.**

We believe in God the Holy Spirit  
**The spirit and the Bride say 'come!'  
Even so come, Lord Jesus!  
Amen** *cf.Revelations*

### The Peace

*The priest may use an introduction to the peace*  
The peace of the Lord be always with you  
**And also with you**

Let us offer one another a sign of that peace

### Preparation of the table

Be present, Lord Jesus Christ, our risen high priest; make yourself known in the breaking of bread and sharing of wine.

### The Eucharistic Prayer (Prayer H)

The Lord is here  
**His Spirit is with us**

Lift up your hearts  
**We lift them to the Lord**

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God  
**It is right to give thanks and praise**

It is right to praise you, father,  
Lord of all creation;  
In your love you made us for yourself.  
When we turned away you did not reject us, but  
came to meet us in your Son  
**You embraced us as your children and  
welcomed us to sit and eat with you.**

In Christ you shared our life that we might live in him and he in us.

**He opened wide his arms of love  
upon the cross and made for all  
the perfect sacrifice for sin.**

On the night he was betrayed, at supper with his friends he took bread, and gave you thanks; he broke it and gave it to them saying:

Take, eat; this is my body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of me.

**Father, we do this in remembrance of him:  
his body is the bread of life.** *Sanctus bell*

At the end of supper, taking the cup of wine, he gave you thanks, and said:

Drink this, all of you; this is my blood of the new covenant, which is poured out for you for the forgiveness of sins;

do this in remembrance of me.

**Father, we do this in remembrance of him:  
His blood is poured out for all.** *Sanctus bell*

As we proclaim his death  
and celebrate his rising in glory,  
Send your Holy Spirit that this bread and this wine may be for us the body and blood of your dear Son.

**As we eat and drink these holy gifts make us  
one in Christ, our risen Lord.**

With your whole church throughout the world we offer you this sacrifice of praise and lift our voice to join the eternal song of heaven:

**Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might,  
heaven and earth are full of your glory.  
Hosanna in the highest.**

**Blessed is he who comes in the name of the  
Lord. Hosanna in the highest.**

*All* **Lord Jesus Christ, present with us now;  
as we do in this place  
what you did in an upstairs room,  
breathe your Spirit upon us  
and upon this bread and wine,  
that they may be  
heaven's food and drink for us,  
renewing, sustaining and making us whole,  
so that we may be your body on earth loving  
and caring in the world. Amen**

As our Saviour taught us so we pray

**Our Father, who art in heaven**

**Hallowed be thy name.**

**Thy kingdom come, thy will be done**

**On earth as it is in heaven.**

**Give us this day our daily bread**
