## Other projects we have started

- 1. Following the success of the fish and chip supper and quiz we have held for the last two years to raise money for Christian Aid week we plan to have three others each year to raise money for the church. A number of non-churchgoers join us for these quizzes. They are an enjoyable way of raising money from a wider range of different pockets and a small team of people from the church are keen to run them! Intergenerational church
