**Please place any donations to the church in the plate on the way into church.**

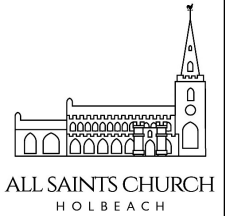

### **Micah 6:1-8**

<sup>1</sup>Hear what the LORD says:

Rise, plead your case before the mountains,  
and let the hills hear your voice.

<sup>2</sup>Hear, you mountains, the controversy of  
the LORD,  
and you enduring foundations of the earth;  
for the LORD has a controversy with his people,  
and he will contend with Israel.

<sup>3</sup>O my people, what have I done to you?  
In what have I wearied you? Answer me!

<sup>4</sup>For I brought you up from the land of Egypt,  
and redeemed you from the house of slavery;  
and I sent before you Moses,  
Aaron, and Miriam.

<sup>5</sup>O my people, remember now what King Balak  
of Moab devised,  
what Balaam son of Beor answered him,  
and what happened from Shittim to Gilgal,  
that you may know the saving acts of the LORD.'

<sup>6</sup>'With what shall I come before the LORD,  
and bow myself before God on high?  
Shall I come before him with burnt-offerings,  
with calves a year old?

<sup>7</sup>Will the LORD be pleased with thousands of  
rams, with tens of thousands of rivers of oil?  
Shall I give my firstborn for my transgression,  
the fruit of my body for the sin of my soul?'

<sup>8</sup>He has told you, O mortal, what is good;  
and what does the LORD require of you  
but to do justice, and to love kindness,  
and to walk humbly with your God?

### **1 John 4:7-19**

<sup>7</sup>Beloved, let us love one another, because love  
is from God; everyone who loves is born of God  
and knows God. <sup>8</sup>Whoever does not love does  
not know God, for God is love. <sup>9</sup>God's love was  
revealed among us in this way: God sent his only  
Son into the world so that we might live through  
him. <sup>10</sup>In this is love, not that we loved God but  
that he loved us and sent his Son to be the aton-  
ing sacrifice for our sins. <sup>11</sup>Beloved, since God  
loved us so much, we also ought to love one an-  
other. <sup>12</sup>No one has ever seen God; if we love  
one another, God lives in us, and his love is per-  
fected in us.

<sup>13</sup>By this we know that we abide in him and he in  
us, because he has given us of his Spirit. <sup>14</sup>And  
we have seen and do testify that the Father has  
sent his Son as the Saviour of the world. <sup>15</sup>God  
abides

in those who confess that Jesus is the Son of  
God, and they abide in God. <sup>16</sup>So we have known  
and believe the love that God has for us.  
God is love, and those who abide in love abide in  
God, and God abides in them. <sup>17</sup>Love has been  
perfected among us in this: that we may have  
boldness on the day of judgement, because as  
he is, so are we in this world. <sup>18</sup>There is no fear  
in love, but perfect love casts out fear; for fear  
has to do with punishment, and whoever fears  
has not reached perfection in love. <sup>19</sup>We  
love because he first loved us.

### **Matthew 22:34-40**

<sup>34</sup>When the Pharisees heard that he had si-  
lenced the Sadducees, they gathered togeth-  
er, <sup>35</sup>and one of them, a lawyer, asked him a  
question to test him. <sup>36</sup>'Teacher, which com-  
mandment in the law is the greatest?' <sup>37</sup>He said  
to him, ' "You shall love the Lord your God with  
all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all  
your mind." <sup>38</sup>This is the greatest and first com-  
mandment. <sup>39</sup>And a second is like it: "You shall  
love your neighbour as yourself." <sup>40</sup>On these  
two commandments hang all the law and the  
prophets.'
