Enjoy the fellowship of spending time with like minded people, learn new skills and produce your own pieces, under the guidance of experts in their field, on one of our Crafty Dabble Days.

Most classes will take place in the Mary Bass Room in Church, but sometimes we shall use The Reading Rooms in Church Street, all will be on a Saturday morning from 10am to 1pm.

Classes are aimed at groups of 5 to 10 Adults and Children over 12.

All materials will be supplied and you will leave with a small item that you have made. There will be a small charge made to cover the costs of the materials, these will vary according to the event you wish to attend.

Saturday March 15th


**Stain It, Stamp It, Stitch It,
£20 per person**

Make a leather Key fob with Jo's Leathercrafts. Jo Ball will be leading the session. You will learn how to stain the leather, stamp a design



onto it and stitch the finished article.


They'll be plenty of stamps including letters and numbers, different stains to choose from and either a silver or copper split ring. 4 choices of thread colours and scrap pieces to practise on. Everything will be supplied including rubber gloves for leather staining, unless you have a latex allergy in which case you will have to bring an alternative.



Saturday April 5th

**Hand Stitch Landscape,
£15 per person**

Make a hand sewn textile picture with Julie Cole textile artist.



You will create a landscape scene using a variety of methods, fabrics and other materials to make a 15cm (6inch) square unique piece of art to take home.

Start with a prepared base fabric, decide which fabrics, organza, cords, beads etc to use. Then stitch in place using a mixture of embroidery stitches. You may wish to frame it, put it inside a card frame, to show off your work. Card frames will be available for sale




Saturday April 26th

The Japanese art of Sashiko

£15 per person

The Japanese art of Sashiko is a form of embroidery derived from darning led by Carole Warner.



An opportunity to learn this ancient art form that can be used to produce a piece of work 15cm (6 inch) square. You will learn how to mark out a grid and stitch a traditional pattern. Then you can choose to frame it or make it into a pin cushion at home. Card frames and wooden bowls will be available for purchase on the day.



Saturday May 17th

Glass Fusion

From £15—£30 per person

Lisa from The Place Stamford

Choose from 1 or 2 projects

You will be shown how to

make either a suncatcher or landscape in glass ranging in size and cost.

As well as the size/price you choose between Full Fuse, (which is a more abstract and pattern based art where you can choose to make a coaster or a suncatcher) or Tack Fuse (which most people do) where you can create a picture to hang like a or prop up. In both forms you can learn how to cut glass, use the grinder, use Powders, Frits, Dots and Stringers.

Mini Suncatchers 3 x10cm = £15

2 x Suncatchers £30

Suncatcher 5 x 10cm = £20

Picture 10 x 10cm = £30

You will need to pre book which option you want to do before the event.

A form of South Asia



Layered fabric and stitching technique

Choose from a Rose, Tulip or Echinacea .

You will choose your pattern from a choice of preprepared fabric, and sew in a variety of stitches. You will also gain an understanding of the preparation needed to try it at home. The finished piece could be incorporated into a larger piece of artwork or framed. Frame cards will be available to purchase on the day.

**Learn to Crochet
and**

**Make a Granny
Square**

The days of the basic Granny square of the 70's are long gone. Learn the basic stitches to make a granny square and see how they can be used.. Once candidates have mastered the basics, Carole will help individuals to follow a pattern to make a modern Granny Square. All you need to try this craft will be supplied as part of the session.



Saturday July 12th

Fabric Stamping

Once again textile artist Julie Cole joins us and we explore

the Art of Fabric Stamping



This session will be an introductory play at artistically stamping on fabric. Attendees will learn firstly using premade stamps and then progress to making their own and using it to decorate a cotton tote bag (supplied) to take away .

Landscape in Watercolours

If you have always fancied yourself as a painter come along and join us. All you need is your imagination. All materials supplied. Phil will guide you on how to use watercolour paints and to compose a pleasing picture to take home with you.

Carole Warner will lead candidates to make a small crochet animal. First of all we will make a small quick heart project. Then once the basics are covered there are a selection of small animals to make.

Knitting a Hat

After a starter lesson to casting on, knit and purl when you feel you have mastered them you can have a go at knitting a hat from a simple pattern, it can be for a baby or larger.

Saturday November 1st

Shrinkables

You will be shown how to make your own decorations using coloured pencils and plastic. You can start from your own drawings or trace from a picture. Use them to add to jewellery, decorations. Several items can be made and please bring a small pair of sharp scissors.
